National Curriculum

Computing: Understand computer networks including the internet; how they can provide multiple services, such as the worldwide web.

Learning Objective

To discuss, design and make a cable car out of recycled material, considering structure, purpose and strength.

Success Criteria

All: with teacher support will be able to find 5 facts about The Heights of Abraham and record 3 to use on their visit.

Most: can independently find facts about miners and the Victorian Visitors and record 5 of them to take on their visit.

Some: can independently find facts about miners and the Victorian Visitors and record a range of facts in the format of a fact file.

Activity

Introduction: Talk about the trip to The Heights of Abraham and ask what the children think the visit will involve?

Teach: talk about a few facts about The Heights of Abraham to get the children thinking about the lives of miners and visitors and what the miners were mining for. What was lead used for in this time period.

Activity: In pairs, groups or individually children need to find out information about their chosen area. These can be the children's decision or the teacher can hand out topics to each pair. Find out at least 5 facts about lead mining/the visitors/ the use of lead. Record the facts as a fact file.

Plenary: Does the child's research match what the cave guide has said. Are some of the facts found true or myth?
